Pursuing degree

It is clear that majority of the respondent pursuing PG degree and others pursuing M.Phil and Ph.D

Program currently pursuing

It is clear that majority of 53.4% of the respondents belong to Science, whereas 30.9% respondents belong to Arts and 15.7% belong to Commerce.

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class

It is clear that Majority of the respondent said that syllabus covered upto 90%, 37.9% of the respondent said that syllabus covered upto 100% and 15.4% of respondents said upto 80%.

How well did the teachers prepare for the classes

It is clear that 61.3% of the respondents said that teachers prepare well for the classes were satisfied and 31.4% of the respondents said that teachers prepare thoroughly for the classes.

How well were the teachers able to communicate?

It is clear that 50% of the teachers were able to communicate always effectively, 30.2% of the teachers were able to communicate sometimes only and 16% of the teachers communication is just satisfied.

The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

It is clear that majority 38.1% of the teachers approach to teaching is very good, 30% of the teachers approach to teaching is excellent and 28.8% were good.

Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

It is clear that 42% were always fair in the internal evaluation process by the teachers, 41.8% usually fair and 12.8% sometimes unfair.

performance in assignments is discussed with students

It is clear that majority 39.2% said that their performance in assignment were discussed with them every time, 32.4% said usually, 17.4 % said sometimes and 8.5% said rarely.

The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

It is clear that majority 35.5% said that the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for student's regularly, 25.8% said sometimes and 24.9% said often.

The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you incognitive, social and emotional growth.

It is clear that majority 55.6% of the respondent said that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth were very well, 18.9% said significant and agreed 17.9% moderate.

The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

It is clear that 45.7% of the respondents agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow whereas 32.1% strongly agree and 17.9% neutral.

Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

It is clear that 38.1% said that the teachers inform about expected competencies, course outcome and programmes outcomes every time, 35% of the respondents said usually and 18.9% said occassionaly.

Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

It is clear that 39.6% of the respondents said that teachers were fully able to identify the weakness and helped to overcome them, 32.4% said reasonably and 16.2% said partially.

The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

It is clear that majority 50.3% of the respondents said that every time the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications whereas 31.1% said usually and 12.6% of the respondents said sometimes.

The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

It is clear that 47.8% of the respondents said that the teachers identify the strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges were full, 27.3% reasonable and 14.3% said partially.

The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

It is clear that 48.1% of the respondents agree that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process, 30.5% of the respondents strongly agree and 16.7% of the respondents neutral.

The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

It is clear that 36.5% of the respondents said that moderate in the teachers use student centric method, 35.3% of the respondents said to a great extent and 18.9% of the respondents said somewhat and 7% of the respondents said that very little.

Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

It is clear that majority 45.7% of the respondents were strongly agree that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities, 33.3% of the respondents said they agree and 12.6% of the respondents said neutral.

Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

It is clear that majority 42.2% of the respondents said that efforts made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work were to a great extent, 33.1% of the respondents said that moderate and 15% of the respondents said somewhat.

Percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

It is clear that 30.9% of the respondents said that above 60% of the teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia while teaching, whereas 26.3% of the respondents said above 70% , 17.2% of the respondents said upto 60% to 50%, 10.8% of the respondents said 50% to 40% and 14.8% of the respondents said below 40%.

The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

It is clear that 47.3% of the respondents agree with the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute were very good, 30% of the respondents were strongly agree and 19.3% of the respondents neutral.

what is the time taken by the institution for declaration of CIA examination results

It is clear that 49% of the respondents said that within 3 days the institution declare the CIA, 29.9% of the respondents said within 3-5 days, 12.6 % of the respondents said within 5-7 days and 6% of the respondents said that above 10 days .

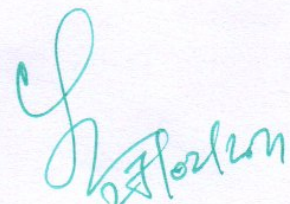
