ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021

Respected members of the Management, Parents, Staff and Students- Assalamu alaikum!

It gives me great pleasure to present the Annual Report of the College for the year 2020-21.

- The College remained closed for Covid'19 and used as a Quarantine centre from April to November 2020. Regular classes for III year UG and II PG began with SOP from 7.11.2020 after a period of 8 months.
- Regular Classes for I & II UG and I PG courses began on 08.02.21 with strict adherence to SOP Guidelines.
- B.Sc. Zoology in UG and II M.Sc. Biochemistry in PG were introduced this year with the approval granted by the University Inspection Commission.

University Inspection Commission

The University Inspection Commission visited the college on 25th August 2020 to verify the infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the college for the continuation affiliation to the courses, III B.Sc. IDD, II M.Sc. Biochemistry. Dr. M. Chitra, Member Syndicate, Thiruvalluvar University, Associate Professor, Department of Mathematics, Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore was the Convener for the University Inspection Commission Committee. The commission was fully satisfied and recommended the University for the grant of affiliation to the above courses to Islamiah Women's Arts and Science College.

ADMISSIONS

- The Admissions for UG & PG courses were extended up to 15.10.2020 & 31.10.2020 respectively.
- 655 students were admitted in UG and 68 students were admitted in PG courses.

EXAM CELL:

- End Semester Examinations were conducted from 14.12.2020 for the 19-20 final year students.
- University Central Valuation commenced on 17.12.2020 in the college campus and was completed within a week.
- University Examinations for Minimum Pass Mark awarded candidates began on 17.02.21 and continued till 24.02.21 and Valuation for the same commenced simultaneously.
- Projects were submitted by the students and Practical examinations conducted from 1.3.21 to 13.3.21.
- End Semester Examinations for I UG & I PG (Odd) and II & III UG and II PG (Even) are scheduled to begin the month of April.
- In all 677 UG and 59 PG students passed their final End Semester Examinations in April 20-21.
